



Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was assassinated in 1968 while supporting over 1,100 striking workers in their fight for a union and justice on the job. Today, approximately 1/3 of all employers in the U.S. give their workers paid-time off in recognition of MLK day.

- **While Starbucks pays a holiday premium for several federal holidays, it does not pay that premium on MLK day.**
- **Though Dr. King is a hero to many Americans and many baristas, Starbucks does not currently treat his holiday the same as others.**
- **The IWW Starbucks Workers Union is calling on Starbucks to recognize this important holiday by paying the time and a half holiday premium that it pays for other holidays.**
